This award recognizes Mercy Regional Medical Center as one of only 38 hospitals in the state for achieving certain improvements in the quality of health care given to their patients.

Previously titled the Louisiana Hospital Quality Awards (platinum, gold, silver and bronze levels), the Louisiana Hospital Capstone Quality Awards are aligned with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' inpatient quality initiatives and recognize hospital achievement in appropriate care for patients with diagnoses of:

- Acute Myocardial Infarction (AMI)
- Heart Failure (HF)
- Community Acquired Pneumonia (PN)
- Improvements in care related to measures outlined in the Surgical Care Improvement Project (SCIP).

The clinical measure sets for the awards have been designated as national health care priorities by CMS. Quality improvement teams at Mercy Regional Medical Center have worked to use evidence-based practices to improve care for their patients.
